

While the main office is in West Philadelphia on Lancaster Avenue, in 2016 AlphaCare added a Mobile Medical Clinic (MMC). The MMC, fully equipped with ultrasound, serves patients in different locations throughout the city. This allows AlphaCare to reach more patients in their own communities

Position Summary

The Nurse Manager's main responsibility is to oversee the logistical and operational needs of the medical program at AlphaCare while also providing direct client services. The Nurse Manager promotes the optimum health of both mother and baby in the pivotal prenatal and postpartum periods from a life-affirming perspective. Beginning with pregnancy testing and ultrasound, this position calls for assessing the clients' physical, emotional and spiritual needs to provide information needed for decision-making, support, education and connection with resources. Services are offered at our main office location in West Philadelphia, as well as on our Mobile Medical Clinic (MMC) in various Philadelphia communities. The Nurse Manager reports directly to the Executive Director, collaborating with the Client Services Director and Project Manager.

Duties and Responsibilities

Direct Client Services

- Promote optimal health of mother and baby in the prenatal and postpartum periods
- Identify and clarify the physical, emotional, and spiritual resources of the client
- Demonstrate understanding of trauma and suffering to meet clients with grace, compassion, and professionalism

Program Administration

- Oversee and manage the nursing staff
- Maintain appropriate licensing and credentials for facilities, medical program, and medical team
- Monitor and implement updates from city, state, national health department, and other sources with support from medical staff, Medical Director, and Program Services Committee
- As applicable update policy and procedure manuals and forms, revising as needed, and implementing adherence among staff to maintain best practice and legal compliance including OSHA, CLIA, HIPAA, etc
- Represent the program status, needs, and stories to Executive Director, Medical Director, Program Committee, Board of Directors, and other invested parties
- Support strategic planning process and execution

Program Development

- Support Executive Director to develop and maintain program partnerships including Mobile Clinic partner sites
- Evaluate and support medical service programs including: prenatal education, childbirth classes, and breastfeeding support
- Assist in the maintenance and development of accurate printed literature and other supporting materials for patients
- Encourage and develop staff and volunteers by relying on God's truth and upholding professional best practice
- Cultivate a Biblical climate of diversity, inclusion, belonging, and trust

Facilities and Asset Management

- Oversee care and maintenance of Mobile Medical Clinic, ultrasound equipment, and medical supplies
- Manage Medical Services and Mobile Medical Clinic budgets determining and communicating fiscal priorities
